Message from the Agent

Congratulations to all our sitting County
Councillors on their re-elections to Devon County Council. Hard work and dedication to duty paid off on the day!
John Hart, the Leader of Devon County Council, has run a very efficient Council over the last four years by freezing council tax, reducing the debts of the County Council by nearly £90 million and delivering good services all on reduced grant from the Government.



John Humphreys, Jill Elson and Chris Wale all fought extremely hard in their divisions and our commiserations to them for not making it to County Hall this time.

We have retained control of Devon County Council with a good working majority of 38 and it is the first time since 1981 that the Conservatives have won two successive County Council elections in Devon.

Thank you to all of you who delivered leaflets and did telling on election day, and thank you to all the candidates for whom I was Election Agent who made the whole the campaign a pleasure to coordinate.

UK Independence Party shook the whole political system and took a County Council seat from the Liberal Democrats in Exmouth. They came second in many of our county seats, pushing Liberal Democrats into third place. We must not forget that the Liberal Democrats were in control of Devon County Council just four years ago; now they only hold nine seats across the whole county!

Cllr John Hart has announced his Cabinet members, two of whom are within the East Devon Constituency; Cllr Andrew Leadbetter who is now the Cabinet Member for Economy, Enterprise and Employment, and will also continue to be the Cabinet member with special responsibility for Exeter and Cllr Stuart Hughes will be the Cabinet member for Highways and Flood Prevention. Cllr Bernard Hughes will be the Chairman of Devon County Council with effect from Thursday 23rd May.

Parliament, Paintings and Politicians - Talk by Rt Hon Hugo Swire MP


